Parking: [Click here for a Seattle University campus map](#). No passes or fees required. Parking is available on the street, at the Connolly Center (at 14th & E Jefferson), at the East Columbia Building (13th Ave & E Cherry), in the Broadway garage (Broadway & E Columbia), and the Murphy garage (on E Cherry between Broadway & 12th Ave).

Please note that due to the urban nature of our campus setting, you may need to walk up to 5-10 blocks roundtrip from your car to the location of the fair.

Be aware that street parking is limited to two hours; cars parked on the street longer than two hours will be subject to citation.

If disability accommodations are needed in order to attend or participate in this event, please contact the fair coordinator via phone or email at least two weeks in advance.

INFORMATION FOR COLLEGE REPRESENTATIVES

Set Up: Representatives may begin unloading and setting up at 10:30am. Please unload materials at the Connolly Center; there will be a load/unload zone on the corner of 14th Ave and East Cherry. Feel free to park at the Connolly Center (P7), in the East Columbia lot (P6) or, if no spaces remain, in either the Broadway or Murphy garages (P3 and P4). A continental brunch will be served at 11:00am.

Representatives should arrive early, as parking near the Connolly Center is limited.

College representatives **should not** park on the street as street parking is limited to two hours; cars parked on the street longer than that duration will be subject to citation.

Estimated attendance: In recent history, anywhere from 1000-1500 students and guests have attended the fair.
