



2017 Summer Credit Retrieval Program Application

Summer Credit Retrieval is a free program that has three fundamental goals:

- Academic skill building
- Credit recovery that leads to on-time graduation
- College and career readiness

Students who enroll in Summer Credit Retrieval will retrieve credit for the Language Arts, Mathematics, and/or Social Studies classes that they did not previously pass. They will also participate in college and career readiness activities. Students may enroll in a total of two classes (from different subject matter areas) and earn up to 1.0 credit (.5 per class) toward graduation.

Students will participate in project based learning opportunities focused on giving students tangible skills to support their academic growth and retrieve credits towards graduation.

The program will be housed at two sites: Ingraham High School and South Lake High School. Every attempt will be made to assign students to their first choice location. Classes run from Wednesday, July 5 through Friday, July 28. Classes run daily, from Monday through Friday from 9:00am-12:00pm. Period 1 is 9:00am - 10:25am and Period 2 from 10:35am to 12:00pm. Full participation and attendance is required. Students will be dropped from the program on their 3rd absence and will receive an "E" for their registered class(es) -- or if they stay the full term and do not complete the class requirements. Students who enroll in the

program will be provided with a King County Metro tickets for the duration of the program to get to and from their school site.

Preference will be given to students in grades 11 and 12 that are the closest to graduation, but all grade levels are encouraged to enroll and a wait list will be developed to fill all the available seats. **Students accepted to the program will be notified by early June through a letter sent to the address provided. The letter will contain instructions about where and when to show up for the first day.**

Students on the wait list will be notified by mail with information about their next steps.
