

Revised Dance Expectations
Effective 1/1/14

It has become evident over the last two years that the dress and the behavior at dances has crossed all acceptable lines of appropriateness for school and changes have to be made. This includes the changes that we have seen to the length and style of dresses. We want to make sure that all changes are as clear as possible, well thought out and considerate of the world around us. Therefore the following changes and areas of emphasis will be in effect starting with Winter Ball 2014:

Bracelets: All attendees will be issued a single use bracelet on your way into the dance. On your first violation of the dance expectations, the bracelet will be cut off. If you violate the expectations again, you will have to leave the dance immediately and may face further school consequences.

Dress: The length of all dresses must at least be as long as the end of the finger tips of the wearer with arms fully extended. Additionally, the dress must not be overly revealing (this includes the top, side or other portion of the dress).

Dancing:

- 45 Degree rule is still in effect
- Hands cannot touch anywhere that traditional underwear touch (this includes both underwear and bras and is defined as the top of the hip bone on the sides)
- Highly sexualized grinding is strictly prohibited

All dancing violations will apply to both partners
