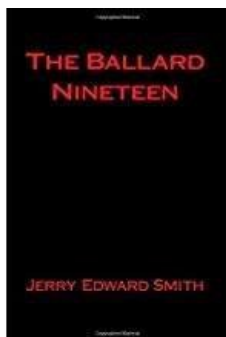


Ballard High School Foundation Ballard Nineteen Scholarship Application 2023

The Ballard High School Foundation offers this scholarship to remember the nineteen men from Ballard High School who died serving in Vietnam. Author Jerry Smith has generously donated the proceeds from his book to fund the scholarship. The book is available in the BHS library.

The Ballard Nineteen Scholarship is a one-time \$1000 award to a graduating senior at Ballard High School to pursue further academic or trade education, given to a student who meets the following criteria:

Requirements, students must:

- Be enrolled as a senior at Ballard High School (relatives involved with the school or BHSF will not participate in consideration of the students they are related to)
- Be a relative of one of The Ballard Nineteen

OR, if no relatives of The Ballard Nineteen qualify for the award:

- Have a parent, grandparent, or sibling in the armed forces.
- Submit with their application a copy of military ID or documentation of family member.
- Write a biographical essay about themselves and their military family member (200-300 words)

Please submit with this application the following:

- One or more letters of recommendation from a teacher or employer (three maximum)
- A personal letter, maximum one page, which outlines your educational / vocational / life goals
- Your resume including school and community activities, work experience, special interests, talents, hobbies, honors & awards.
- Please tell us how this scholarship will help you with your financial need.

Note: High School transcript (required) will be added to your application by the counseling office

Special consideration will be given to applicants planning to attend a school or a program with a military focus.

Completed application packets will be reviewed by the Ballard High School Foundation Golden Beaver Scholarship Committee. You will be notified by email of the committee's decision. Please email Carol Bristol (chbristol@seattleschools.org) in the Counseling Center if you have questions.
