


# Ballard High School Foundation Daniel Chavez Scholarship Application 2024

The Daniel Chavez Scholarship is a one-time \$1000 award to a graduating senior at Ballard High School to pursue further academic or trade education, given to a student who meets the following criteria:

### Requirements, students must:

- Be enrolled as a senior at Ballard High School (relatives involved with the school or BHSF will not participate in consideration of the students they are related to)
- Be a relative of Daniel Chavez or have a parent, grandparent, or sibling in the armed forces
- Submit with their application a copy of military ID or documentation of family member
- Write a biographical essay about themselves and their military family member (200-300 words)

### Please submit the following with this application:

- A letter of recommendation from a teacher or employer
- A personal letter, maximum one page, which outlines your educational / vocational / life goals. Please tell us how this scholarship will help regarding your life circumstances.
- Your resume including school and community activities, work experience, special interests, talents, hobbies, honors & awards.
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Note: High School transcript (required) will be added to your application by the counseling office. Special Consideration will be given to applicants planning to attend a school or program with a military focus.

Completed application packets will be reviewed by the Ballard High School Foundation Golden Beaver Scholarship Committee. You will be notified by email of the committee's decision.
